Writing a business plan. ugh. This is definitely not the most exciting part of starting a business. This is an intelligence process in which you can evaluate your options, test your assumptions about your idea and even discover new opportunities. It may even lead you to kill aspects of your business before investing too much time or money in them. That doesn't mean you have to bust with Word and start the plan from scratch. The template is great - you probably don't do anything you haven't done before, so it provides a proven structure for your plan. Almost everything on it can be customized. Check out these comprehensive business plan templates that you can download for free so you start: Score is an American nonprofit dedicated to helping entrepreneurs get their companies off the ground. Its template, available in PDF or Word format, asks 150 whopping questions and is versatile enough to set up for most business types. Refining the resource plan that comes with it is useful, especially if it's your first crack at writing a business plan. The SBA template is available for online filing and then downloaded as a PDF. You can go back and edit it as needed, so don't worry about whether everything is ready the first time you sit down to solve it. Even broken down into sections, it's a long document and a bit of a slog to go through, but it produces a professional and useful business plan. This is especially useful if your idea is not completely supplanted and you know what you have homework to do - it encourages you to information. It contains 10 broad sections, including market analysis, management and organization, etc., with one paragraph explaining each. The second download on the same page is an Excel file that helps with financial forecasts. Of course, Microsoft offers a ton of business plan templates for Office users (you can get a birthday invitation when you're on it). If you want to make a business plan presentation than a Word document, you can download one of the half-dozen or so Microsoft Office PowerPoint templates for that purpose. You want to customize it with a branded company (you have branding down, right?), but it's easier than starting with an empty PPT. Global financial services firm vFinance offers a basic, 30-page business plan template to download from its website - one, according to the company, has been downloaded more than a quarter of a million times. No, it won't be entirely unique, but vFinance knows what it's doing and the pattern is pretty comprehensive. vFinance is the creator of a massive venture capital catalog and has adapted the plan to appeal to g financiers. If that's your goal, definitely check out this out.U.K. online invoicing software brand Invoiceberry offers free business plan templates in .docx, .odt, .xlsx and .pptx formats. Each also contains a marketing plan and resume template.
